MSWhse December 2023 Fixes

In addition to numerous other bugs for which documentation is not needed, the following cases were resolved:

Transactions: Outbound

Photos for Item Numbers that are not currently in stock are showing in Item Number photo selector.

Items that are not currently in stock do not show within outbound transaction selectors. The bug involved the photos of item numbers not in stock showing in the photo selector. It would not list if the item number was entered to filter the list; however, the photo of the item was incorrectly showing.

Vaults

A vault that had been in use is still showing listed as in use for the now inactivated customer.

The issue occurred when a vault in use for a customer had all its items outbounded but was still showing in use by the customer. The customer was a CFW, or Customer Facing Web, customer. When the project was finished, the customer was deactivated; however, the vault was still showing as in use by the customer. When the customer was reactivated to adjust the vault location, the vault was not showing as associated to the customer, so it could not be adjusted.

The logic for vault location has been redeveloped to avoid the issue.
