Feature: Outbound Transactions

“Delivery Ticket 2” is new!

When outbounding a transaction that includes Inventory Numbers, use Delivery Ticket 2 (shown in Figure 1) which is organized by Inventory Number. If there is an item on the ticket that doesn't have an Inventory Number, that item will be listed at the end of that ticket. Note the last item in the list doesn't have an Inventory; therefore, it is at the bottom of the list.

Delivery Ticket 2 can be accessed by clicking the three dots (⋮) within **Outbound Processing** and **Outbound Completed**.

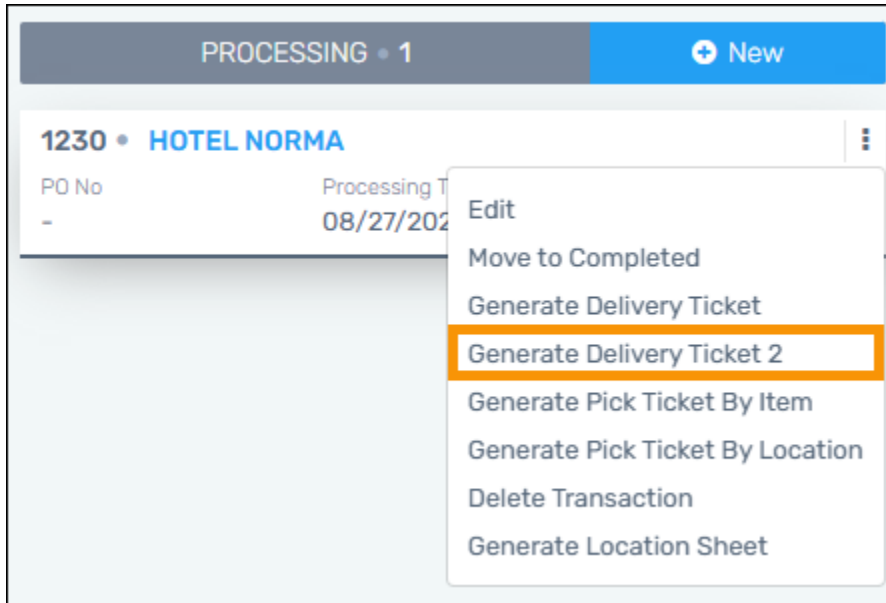


Figure 2: Outbound Processing Menu expanded to show Delivery Ticket 2.

Inventory Numbers can be added to Item Numbers during the inbound processing. Just enter the number in the Inventory No. field to attach the Inventory Number to that quantity of that Item Number.

The option to choose Inventory Numbers is available during the outbounding process. If there isn't an Inventory Number attached to that Item Number, the dropdown will just have the "Without Inventory" option. If there is an Inventory Number, it will list in the dropdown.

Fix: Billing & Payments

Generating large volume of Anniversary Date billing caused the process to time out.

Logic has been improved to make sure the billing process will complete regardless of the number of Anniversary Date invoices being generated.

Fix: Customers

Multiple kittings could be created unintentionally.

When creating a kitting, repeated clicking of “Save” was resulting in duplicates kittings – all with the same name and contents. This should not happen and now only one kitting will save.

INTERNAL REFERENCE: WD-4396

Fix: Locations

Moving pallets with a position to a location where positions are not allowed no longer create a new location.

When moving quantity from a pallet that has a position to a location where positions are not allowed, the system is incorrectly retaining the original position and assigning it to the new location.

This behavior results in invalid data, as the target location does not support positions, and therefore the position should be set to “None” during the move,
