### AtlasNet Document Upload FEATURE

Manually or automatically send documents to AtlasNet.

Atlas agents can now send documents to AtlasNet. This feature is available to all qualified Atlas orders. A right-click option from within the Document Management Viewer allows you to "Send to Atlas..."

In addition to the manual send, you can set up rules within the new Document (Auto-Upload) Setup to automatically send documents added to the viewer to AtlasNet.

### AtlasNet Download PDF Only ENHANCEMENT

At the request of several Atlas agents, documents downloaded from AtlasNet come into MoversSuite as PDF. Prior to this enhancement, documents also came down in various image formats, which did not allow annotation within the MSCrew mobile application.

Document Viewer BUG

When a file with an unsupported character in the name is saved within the Document Viewer, the unsupported special character is replaced with an underscore.

There are certain characters that are not accepted as filenames within MoversSuite. With this update and to prevent errors, MoversSuite will automatically replace the unsupported character with an underscore. As an example, the filename "Smith/Office.docx" will be saved as "Smith Office.docx".

# Local Dispatch BUG

Declining a local service that has auto-dispatchable equipment will no longer incorrectly "dispatch" the local service.

When one or more equipment types are set to auto-dispatch by quantity on a local service, declining that local service was dispatching the service; however, because of this bug, it did. This is not correct, and this has fixed.

### **EnterpriseBI**

The BI Tool has a new release - Version 24.1.1.656.

Within this new release are two new export options: *Export to PDF (formatted)* and *Export to Excel (formatted)*. Also, a bug fix was implemented so that the Up and Down buttons now worked properly when organizing BI Tool Views within the BI Tool Report Listing.

# Functionality ENHANCEMENT

#### Time zones are determined by browser location.

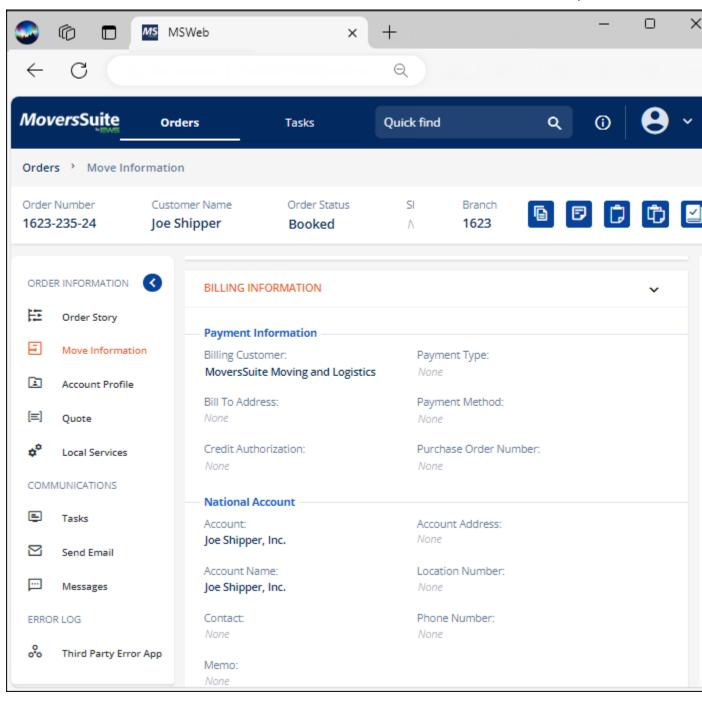
All "Coordinated Universal Time" or "UTC" based processes – such as timestamps – are converted to the browser's time zone, which is what displays for the end-user. This is needed to accurately identify the correct time for sending and receiving text messages and emails through MSWeb.

#### Layout and Fields have improved for better viewing and use.

To better organize information, subsections are grouped under blue headers and a line graphic to separate subsections. "Cards" have effects to make visually more dynamic. Grid layouts and other behind the scenes processes are improved to reduce the time needed to adjust things in the future.

# **Version 2024.09 Known Issues**

The following issues are problems that may affect your decision to upgrade to this version of MoversSuite. The following issues are not resolved for this release.

# QuickBooks Support for IE11 Deprecating for Authorization Screens (September 8, 2020)

Due to security requirements, starting Sept. 8, 2020, only Chromium-based embedded browsers will be supported for **QuickBooks Online Connection Authorization** screens and Internet Explorer 11-based embedded browsers will no longer work.

For authorization process in MoversSuite, the previous two versions of Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, Microsoft Edge, and Safari (11+) are supported. This is for the users who first turn the QuickBooks feature on. Or, in case, the feature is being used after a long while. Refer to this blog for further details on changes made.

#### **Supported Windows Themes**

Related to the scaling issue (listed below), MoversSuite recommends that if your client server is on Windows 10, that you avoid using themes developed for earlier versions of Windows. In other words, please load and use themes developed for the current version of Windows that you are on.

#### Screen scaling not available with MoversSuite

With the advances in screen size and resolution, many underlying applications are not able to deal with all the variations in configurations available to the variety of high definition (HD) screens, such as not being able to read field labels, etc. Due to this limitation, MoversSuite cannot scale as desired in all situations. **UPDATE:** With the release of MoversSuite 2018 R15, a solution has been implemented to address many of the issues involving scaling. (3705, 4114)

Until there is a better solution to scaling, EWS Group recommends that if you experience scaling problems with the MoversSuite application keep the size of your application to 100% and change the resolution as desired. On Windows machines, you can verify and/or update the display settings as follows:

- 1. Right-click somewhere on your desktop and select **Display Settings**
- 2. Set the Change the size of text, apps, and other items to 100%.
- 3. Click on Apply to save the changes.
- 4. Click on Advanced display settings.
- **5.** Make changes to the **Resolution** as needed.
- 6. Click on Apply to save the changes.
- 7. Close the screen by pressing the **X** in the upper right-hand corner of the screen.
